This plan is part of the university's broader commitment to creating an inclusive, supportive, and high-quality learning environment.

The Tutoring Plan

1. Addressing Students' Poor Academic Performance

- Online Tutoring Courses: Tailored to students struggling academically, these courses
 provide personalized guidance from tutors. The integration of knowledge about the
 UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) helps students develop a global
 perspective.
- Study Work-Time Financial Aid Program: This initiative allows students to earn financial aid while receiving academic support, alleviating financial stress and enhancing academic focus.

2. Supporting Diverse Learning Goals

- Tutoring from Donated Entrepreneurs: Entrepreneurs mentor students, helping them
 achieve diverse learning goals, from competition participation to entrepreneurial
 activities.
- Plan for Enterprises to Join Hands to Realize Dreams: This initiative fosters universityindustry partnerships, providing students with real-world experiences and resources to achieve their academic and professional dreams.

Comprehensive Support System

NCUT has also implemented a **Comprehensive and Safe Study Plan** to provide financial and academic support for disadvantaged students. This plan includes:

1. Subsidies for Disadvantaged Students:









 Registration, Transportation, and Accommodation Fees: NCUT offers subsidies for students from rural or outlying areas, reducing the financial burden during the application process.

2. Scholarships and Financial Assistance:

 Work-Study Grants and Scholarships: Tailored scholarships and fee exemptions help ease the financial load on disadvantaged students, including international students.

3. Flexible Study System:

 Four-Year Bachelor's Flexible Study Program: Allows working students to complete graduation credits over 10 years, accommodating work schedules and improving their professional abilities.

4. Credit Accumulation and Transfer System:

 Facilitates the mutual transfer of credits between systems, allowing students to gradually meet graduation requirements and obtain degrees flexibly.

5. Priority Admissions for Disadvantaged Students:

 Bonus Point Mechanism: Provides additional points and priority admission for economically disadvantaged students, increasing their chances of acceptance.

6. Support for Women in STEM Fields:

• STEM Scholarships and Admission Benefits: Encourages female students to pursue degrees in traditionally male-dominated fields like engineering by offering scholarships and additional admission points.

NCUT's 2023 Tutoring Plan ensures that economically and culturally disadvantaged students can achieve academic success through targeted tutoring, financial aid, and flexible learning options. By fostering a supportive, inclusive environment, NCUT prepares students for both academic success and professional development, ensuring that no one is left behind.
