NCUT has established a **comprehensive and inclusive financial support ecosystem** to ensure that economically disadvantaged students—both domestic and international—can complete their studies without being hindered by financial barriers. The system integrates **tuition exemptions, living subsidies, scholarships, emergency relief, and flexible academic arrangements**, thereby fulfilling the university’s mission of equitable education access and contributing directly to **SDG 1 (No Poverty)** and **SDG 4 (Quality Education)**

2. Support Structure and Administration

- **Committee for Economically and Culturally Disadvantaged Students**
Oversees program implementation, monitors impact, and ensures transparency.
- **Online Application & Monitoring System**
Students can apply for aid, track application progress, and receive updates in real time.
- **Data-Driven Improvement**
Regular evaluations lead to policy refinements and optimized resource allocation.

3. Additional Inclusive Measures

1. **Flexible Study Pilot Program** – Allows working students up to 10 years to complete degrees, enabling them to balance employment and education.
2. **Integration of External Donations** – Collaboration with **corporate sponsors, alumni associations, and government agencies** to expand the funding base.
3. **Support for Students with Disabilities** – Tuition aid, accessibility services, and specialized counseling.
4. **Respect for Academic Choice** – Financial support does not restrict major or program selection.

4. Impact Assessment (2023 → 2024)

- ↑ 8.5 % increase in recipients of disadvantaged student aid.



- ↑ **10.5 % increase in tuition-fee waivers**, reflecting enhanced access.
- ↑ **130 % growth in emergency relief funding**, demonstrating stronger resilience mechanisms.
- **Steady industry-university collaboration** ensured sustainable, employment-linked support.

These results highlight NCUT’s effectiveness in **reducing economic inequality**, improving student retention, and aligning financial aid policy with long-term educational equity objectives.

- 一、為因應經濟環境惡化，協助學生安定就學，紓緩其經濟困境，特訂定本要點。
二、經費來源：校內外捐款。
三、申請資格：

凡本校在籍之本國學生(在職專班學生、延修生除外)家庭年所得 70 萬以下(其中利息及上市公司股票利息合計未逾 1 萬元)，家庭財產在 260 萬元以下。因父母雙亡、單親且原為監護人之父或母亡故或父母、監護人、學生本人(限進修部非在職專班且已婚學生)非自願性失業 1 個月以上且尚未就業者、因案入獄服刑、行蹤不明或其他因素。確因家庭經濟因素無力繳納學、雜費而影響就學，經導師查證屬實者。

※家庭年所得及財產之計算：未婚學生應含學生父母或監護人、學生本人；已婚學生應含本人、配偶、子女。學生之父母或配偶如具國民中小學或幼稚園教師、軍人身分者，如未能檢附國稅局開立之所得清單者，應檢附就職學校或機關開立之薪資所得證明，據以列計所得。

四、申請限制：

- 一、已申請政府各類學雜費減免經審核為全免者、父母任公職領有子女教育補助費者，不得申請本項紓困金。
二、已申請政府各類學雜費減免、大專校院弱勢學生助學計畫助學金者以補足其當學期應繳之學雜費為限。

五、給付標準：最多核給當學期應繳之學雜費總額。每學期以核給 5 名為原則，超額申請者，依審核分數高者優先核給。同分者，則以前一學期學業成績高低排序，其次依操行成績排序。每人每學年限申請乙次。

六、申請時間：每學期期中考前。

七、應檢附文件：

1. 申請表。
2. 學生證影本。
3. 前一學期成績單。
4. 當期學雜費繳費單。
5. 父母、監護人、學生本人(限進修部非在職專班且已婚學生)失業者：非自願性離職證明【以行政院勞工委員會職業訓練局就業服務站(中心)開立之「失業(再)認定、失業給付申請書及給付收據」或「失業認定聯」為認定標準】或導師查訪證明。
父母亡故：死亡證明或除戶證明。
因案入獄服刑、行蹤不明或其他因素者：相關證明。
6. 最近一年國稅局開立之全戶所得及財產清單(未婚學生應含未婚學生應含學生父母(監護人)、學生本人；已婚學生應含本人、配偶、子女。惟學生之父母或配偶具國民中小學或幼稚園教師、軍人身分者，如未能檢附國稅局開立之所得清單者，應檢附其就職學校或機關開立之薪資所得證明。
7. 最近三個月內戶籍謄本：未婚學生應含學生父母(監護人)、學生本人；已婚學生應含本人、配偶、子女。

Stable Study Assistance Fund Implementation Guidelines

Supporting Economically Disadvantaged Students in Completing Higher Education

1. Purpose

National Chin-Yi University of Technology (NCUT) established the *Stable Study Assistance Fund* to help economically disadvantaged students overcome financial difficulties and maintain stable learning conditions. This initiative demonstrates NCUT's strong commitment to equitable access to education and its alignment with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG

2. Funding Source

The assistance fund is composed of:

- Donations from the university's internal and external stakeholders.
- Allocations from NCUT's welfare and educational support budgets.

3. Eligibility

The fund primarily assists **students facing severe financial hardship**, including those whose:

- Family annual income does not exceed **NT\$700,000**, with total household assets under **NT\$2.6 million**.
- Parents or guardians are **unemployed, underemployed, deceased, or incapacitated**, resulting in an inability to provide sufficient educational support.
- Students are orphans, single-parent dependents, or from families under government-recognized low-income or near-low-income categories.

The policy extends to undergraduate and continuing education students (excluding in-service master's students).

4. Application Restrictions

- Students who already receive equivalent government financial aid, scholarships, or subsidies for the same purpose are not eligible for duplicate funding.
- Applications are open once per semester and are subject to academic performance review and financial need verification.

5. Grant Amount and Selection

- Up to five students per department per semester are selected based on their financial status and academic performance.
- The amount of assistance depends on available funding and the severity of the applicant's financial situation.
- Priority is given to students demonstrating academic diligence and strong financial need.



- The typical grant amount covers a significant portion of tuition and living expenses.

6. Required Documentation

Applicants must submit:

- Application form.
- Certificate of financial hardship (household income and property statement).
- Academic transcript for the most recent semester.
- Proof of parental or guardian employment, unemployment, or loss of income.
- Certificate of family status (low-income proof, household registration, or guardianship documents).
- Other supporting materials verifying financial difficulties.

7. Review and Evaluation Process

Applications are reviewed by the *Student Affairs Office* and the *Financial Aid Review Committee*.

- Verification includes checking tax records, household registry data, and prior scholarship history.
- Evaluation criteria combine academic performance, attendance, and demonstrated need.
- The committee ensures fairness and prioritizes transparency in fund allocation.

8. Payment and Disbursement

Approved grants are distributed through the university's financial system before the end of each semester.

- Payments are deposited directly into the student's designated account.
- Records of recipients are maintained for audit and performance tracking.
- Recipients are encouraged to continue their studies and maintain academic standards to remain eligible in subsequent semesters.

9. Expected Impact

The NCUT *Stable Study Assistance Fund* ensures that financial hardship does not interrupt students' education.

- It directly contributes to reducing dropout rates among low-income students.
- It fosters educational equality by ensuring that all students, regardless of economic status, have access to learning opportunities.



- It reinforces NCUT's broader inclusion strategy under the *Comprehensive Higher Education Support Mechanism* program.
